HOUSE BILL 2612

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER FUND.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; trauma recovery center fund; state
3 pilot trauma recovery center

4 A. The sum of \$7,000,000 is appropriated from the state general
5 fund in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the trauma recovery center fund
6 established by section 36-4102, Arizona Revised Statutes.

7 B. Not more than five percent of the monies appropriated to the
8 fund by subsection A of this section may be used by the department of
9 health services to administer the fund. The remaining monies shall be
10 used by the department to provide all of the following:

11 1. Funding for a technical assistance grant to help establish,
12 train and coordinate a state pilot trauma recovery center.

13 2. Three years of funding to help cover operational and service
14 costs of the state pilot trauma recovery center.

15 3. Funding for a grant to a public research institution to track
16 data and outcomes of the state pilot trauma recovery center and to produce
17 a report at the conclusion of the pilot.
