AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-1723, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT FUND.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1723, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 41-1723. Public safety equipment fund; distribution

5 A. The public safety equipment fund is established consisting of  
6 monies deposited in the fund pursuant to sections 12-116.04, 28-1381,  
7 28-1382, 28-1383, 28-8284, 28-8286, 28-8287 and 28-8288. The department  
8 shall administer the fund.

9 B. The first ~~one million two hundred thousand dollars~~ \$1,200,000  
10 deposited in the public safety equipment fund each fiscal year pursuant to  
11 sections 28-1381, 28-1382, 28-1383, 28-8284, 28-8286, 28-8287 and 28-8288  
12 is continuously appropriated to the department for vehicles, protective  
13 armor, electronic stun devices and other safety equipment. Monies  
14 appropriated pursuant to this subsection are exempt from the provisions of  
15 section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

16 C. Monies deposited in the public safety equipment fund pursuant to  
17 section 12-116.04 are subject to legislative appropriation and shall be  
18 used by the department for vehicles, protective armor, electronic stun  
19 devices and other safety equipment.

20 D. Notwithstanding subsection A of this section and sections  
21 28-1381, 28-1382, 28-1383, 28-8284, 28-8286, 28-8287 and 28-8288, in each  
22 fiscal year, after the first ~~one million two hundred thousand dollars~~  
23 \$1,200,000 is deposited in the public safety equipment fund pursuant to  
24 sections 28-1381, 28-1382, 28-1383, 28-8284, 28-8286, 28-8287 and 28-8288,  
25 the state treasurer shall deposit the remaining monies received pursuant  
26 to sections 28-1381, 28-1382, 28-1383, 28-8284, 28-8286, 28-8287 and  
27 28-8288 in the state general fund.
