# HOUSE BILL 2062

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE REVIEW OF AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ASSURED  
WATER SUPPLY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Certificate of assured water supply; review;  
3 delayed repeal  
4 A. On request of an eligible applicant, the department of water  
5 resources shall review the merits of an application for a certificate of  
6 assured water supply and shall issue a new written determination of action  
7 within fifteen days if all of the following apply:  
8 1. The application is for a certificate of assured water supply in  
9 the Phoenix active management area.  
10 2. The application was submitted on or after January 26, 2021 and  
11 on or before May 31, 2023.  
12 3. The applicant has not received a certificate of assured water  
13 supply, or the application has been denied as of the effective date of  
14 this section.  
15 B. The department shall review the determination to grant a  
16 certificate using either the 2006-2009 Salt River valley regional model or  
17 the 2006 Lower Hassayampa Sub-basin groundwater flow model and any  
18 financial information submitted by the applicant.  
19 C. Within five days after the effective date of this section, the  
20 department shall notify all eligible applicants of the ability to have  
21 their determinations of assured water supply reviewed.  
22 D. Eligible applicants shall request that the department review  
23 their applications within ninety days after the effective date of this  
24 section.  
25 E. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2024.  
26 (ENACTED WITHOUT THE EMERGENCY)  
27 Sec. 2. Emergency  
28 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
29 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
30 law.
