AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; department of education; Arizona
3 Holocaust education center; exemption

4 A. The following amounts are appropriated in the following fiscal
5 years from the state general fund to the department of education to
6 distribute to the Arizona Holocaust education center for the creation and
7 operation of the center as a resource for fulfilling the requirements of
8 section 15-701.02, Arizona Revised Statutes:

9 1. \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2024-2025.

10 2. \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2025-2026.

11 3. \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2026-2027.

12 B. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are
13 exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes,
14 relating to lapsing of appropriations.
