A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 11, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO ELECTION DATES.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article VII, section 11, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to
4 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 11. General elections; date

7 Section 11. There shall be a general election of
8 representatives in congress, and of state, county, CITY, TOWN,
9 SCHOOL DISTRICT and precinct officers on the first Tuesday
10 after the first Monday in November of the first even numbered
11 year after the year in which Arizona is admitted to statehood
12 and biennially thereafter.

13 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
14 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
15 Constitution of Arizona.
