

PROPOSED

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.C.R. 1010

(Reference to Senate engrossed resolution)

1 Strike everything after the resolving clause and insert:

2 "1. Article V, section 12, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to  
3 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the  
4 Governor:

5 12. Compensation of elective state officers;  
6 commission on salaries for elective state  
7 officers

8 Section 12. A. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION C OF  
9 THIS SECTION, THE SALARY OF THOSE HOLDING THE OFFICE OF STATE  
10 LEGISLATOR SHALL BE THE AMOUNT MOST RECENTLY APPROVED BY THE  
11 VOTERS AS ADJUSTED, ON THE SECOND MONDAY IN JANUARY OF EACH  
12 YEAR, UP OR DOWN FOR INFLATION OR DEFLATION PURSUANT TO THE  
13 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, OR ITS SUCCESSOR INDEX, AS PUBLISHED BY  
14 THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, BUREAU OF LABOR  
15 STATISTICS, OR ITS SUCCESSOR AGENCY.

16 B. The salaries of those holding elective state offices  
17 OTHER THAN THE OFFICE OF STATE LEGISLATOR shall be as  
18 established by law from time to time, subject to the  
19 limitations of article ~~6~~ VI, section 33 OF THIS CONSTITUTION  
20 and to the limitations of article ~~4~~ IV, part 2, section 17 OF  
21 THIS CONSTITUTION. Such salaries as are presently established  
22 may be altered from time to time by the procedure established  
23 in this section or as otherwise provided by law, ~~except that~~

1 ~~legislative salaries may be altered only by the procedures~~  
2 ~~established in this section.~~

3 C. A commission to be known as the commission on  
4 salaries for elective state officers is authorized to be  
5 established by the legislature. The commission shall be  
6 composed of five members WHO ARE appointed from private life,  
7 two of whom shall be appointed by the governor and one each by  
8 the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of  
9 representatives, and the chief justice. At such times as may  
10 be directed by the legislature, the commission shall report to  
11 the governor with recommendations concerning the rates of pay  
12 of elected state officers. The governor, ~~shall upon~~ ON the  
13 receipt of such report, SHALL make recommendations to the  
14 legislature with respect to the exact rates of pay ~~which he~~  
15 THAT THE GOVERNOR deems advisable for those offices and  
16 positions other than for the rates of pay of members of the  
17 legislature. Such recommendations shall become effective at a  
18 time established by the legislature after the transmission of  
19 the recommendation of the governor without aid of further  
20 legislative action unless, within such period of time, there  
21 has been enacted into law a statute ~~which~~ THAT establishes  
22 rates of pay other than those proposed by the governor, or  
23 unless either house of the legislature specifically disapproves  
24 all or part of the governor's recommendation. The  
25 recommendations of the governor, unless disapproved or altered  
26 within the time provided by law, shall be effective; ~~and any~~  
27 ~~1971 recommendations shall be effective as to all offices on~~  
28 ~~the first Monday in January of 1973.~~ In case of either a  
29 legislative enactment or disapproval by either house, the  
30 recommendations shall be effective only insofar as not altered  
31 or disapproved. The recommendations of the commission as to  
32 legislative salaries shall be certified by it to the secretary

1 of state and the secretary of state shall submit to the  
2 qualified electors at the next regular general election the  
3 question, "Shall the recommendations of the commission on  
4 salaries for elective state officers concerning legislative  
5 salaries be accepted? [ ] Yes [ ] No." Such recommendations  
6 if approved by the electors shall become effective at the  
7 beginning of the next regular legislative session without any  
8 other authorizing legislation. All recommendations ~~which~~ THAT  
9 become effective under this section shall supersede all laws  
10 enacted ~~prior to~~ BEFORE their effective date relating to such  
11 salaries.

12 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the  
13 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,  
14 Constitution of Arizona."
