HB 2107: department of homeland security; continuation Sponsor: Representative Payne, LD 27 Transmitted to the Governor

Overview

Continues the Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) for four years.

<u>History</u>

AZDOHS is responsible for creating plans to respond to terrorism, cybersecurity threats and other critical hazards and to distribute state and federal monies for homeland security (A.R.S. § 41-4254). AZDOHS has three main roles in fulfilling its responsibilities including serving as: 1) an advisory agency to the Governor and her staff; 2) a grant administrative agency responsible for managing various Homeland Security Grant Programs; and 3) the Statewide Information Security and Privacy Office (A.R.S. § 41-4282).

Provisions

- 1. Continues, retroactive to July 1, 2024, AZDOHS until July 1, 2028. (Sec. 2, 4)
- 2. Repeals AZDOHS on July 1, 2029. (Sec. 2)
- 3. Contains a purpose statement. (Sec. 3)
- 4. Makes a conforming change. (Sec. 1)
