SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1008

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

**RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF STATE LEGISLATURES
ON ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY IN 2025.**

1 Whereas, founded in 1975, the National Conference of State
2 Legislatures (NCSL) has evolved during the past half century to become the
3 premier organization solely dedicated to serving state and territorial
4 legislators and legislative staff; and

5 Whereas, NCSL was established from the merger of three organizations
6 that served or represented state legislatures and that shared the belief
7 that legislative service is one of democracy's worthiest pursuits; and

8 Whereas, NCSL is a bipartisan organization with three objectives: to
9 advance the effectiveness, independence and integrity of state
10 legislatures; to foster interstate communication and cooperation; and to
11 ensure states have a strong, cohesive voice in the federal system; and

12 Whereas, our nation's state legislatures are America's laboratories
13 of democracy and have continually shown that they are the bodies to tackle
14 emerging challenges; and

15 Whereas, state legislatures are where people from very different
16 backgrounds, representing very different communities, can come together
17 and find common ground; and

18 Whereas, for nearly fifty years, NCSL has facilitated the exchange
19 of ideas, provided critical research and information and encouraged a
20 rigorous review of complex issues confronting our communities, states and
21 nation, and NCSL strives to strengthen the bonds between America's state
22 legislatures and the international community.

23 Therefore

24 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
25 Representatives concurring:

26 That the Members of the Legislature recognize the National
27 Conference of State Legislatures for nearly fifty years of superb
28 leadership and service and commend its many dedicated employees over the
29 years for their commitment to the legislative institution.
