1 Page 1, between lines 1 and 2, insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 15-251, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-251. Powers and duties: salary

5 A. The superintendent of public instruction shall:

6 1. Superintend the schools of this state.

7 2. Request the auditor general to investigate when necessary the
8 accounts of school monies kept by any state, county or district officer.

9 3. Subject to supervision by the state board of education, apportion
10 to the several counties the monies to which each county is entitled for the
11 year. Apportionment shall be made as provided in chapter 9 of this title.

12 4. Execute, under the direction of the state board of education, the
13 policies that have been decided on by the state board.

14 5. Direct the performance of executive, administrative or
15 ministerial functions by the department of education or divisions or
16 employees of the department.

17 6. Provide information to the state board of education related to
18 the powers and duties set forth in section 15-203.

19 B. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC
20 INSTRUCTION IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY EQUAL TO EIGHTY-FIVE
21 PERCENT OF THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT."

8 41-1903. Function; exemptions

9 A. Beginning in 2002, the commission shall biennially conduct a
10 review of the rates of pay of elective state officers, of justices and
11 judges of courts of record and of clerks of the superior court. Such
12 review by the commission shall be made for the purpose of determining and
13 providing the pay levels appropriate to the duties and responsibilities of
14 the respective offices and positions subject to such review. The
15 commission may hold public hearings to aid it in its work.

16 B. The commission shall submit to the governor ~~no~~ NOT later than
17 June 1 a report of the results of each review conducted by the commission
18 of the offices and positions subject to this chapter, together with its
19 recommendations.

20 C. THE FOLLOWING STATE OFFICERS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS CHAPTER:

- 21 1. THE GOVERNOR.
22 2. THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR.
23 3. THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
24 4. THE STATE TREASURER.
25 5. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.
26 6. THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION."
