HOUSE BILL 2046

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 13-923, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PROBATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 13-923, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:
4 13-923. Persons convicted of sexual offenses; annual
5 probation review hearing; report; notification
6 A. If requested by the probationer, the court shall conduct a
7 probation hearing at least once a year for a probationer who is under
8 twenty-two years of age and who was convicted of an offense that occurred
9 when the person was under eighteen years of age and that requires the
10 probationer to register pursuant to section 13-3821.
11 B. This section does not preclude the court from conducting more
12 than one probation review hearing each year.
13 C. The probation department that is supervising the probationer
14 shall prepare a probation report and submit the report to the court ~~prior~~
15 ~~to~~ BEFORE the hearing.
16 D. The following individuals shall be notified of the PROBATION
17 hearing AND ANY PREHEARING THAT ARE HELD PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION:
18 1. A prosecutor.
19 2. An attorney for the probationer.
20 3. Any victim or victim's attorney who has a right to be present
21 and heard pursuant to the victims' bill of rights, article II, section
22 2.1, ~~of the~~ Constitution of ~~this state~~ ARIZONA, ~~title 13,~~ chapter 40 OF
23 THIS TITLE or court rule.
24 4. The probation officer supervising the probationer.
25 E. At the hearing, after hearing from those present pursuant to
26 subsection D of this section, the court shall consider the following:
27 1. Whether to continue, modify or terminate probation.
28 2. Whether to continue to require, to suspend or to terminate the
29 probationer's registration pursuant to section 13-3821.
30 3. Whether to continue, defer or terminate community notification
31 pursuant to section 13-3825.
32 F. The court may hold a prehearing involving the persons listed in
33 subsection D of this section to discuss and advise the court concerning
34 the issues listed in subsection E of this section.
