1 The memorial as proposed to be amended is reprinted as follows:

2 To the [~~Arizona Department of Transportation~~] [State Board on Geographic
3 and Historic Names]:

4 Your memorialist respectfully represents:

5 Whereas, Donald J. Trump was the 45th and is the 47th duly elected
6 President of the United States; and

7 Whereas, in the 2024 presidential election, Donald J. Trump won the
8 popular vote, becoming the first Republican nominee for president to do so
9 in 20 years; and

10 Whereas, Donald J. Trump has established the Department of
11 Government Efficiency, which will dismantle government bureaucracy,
12 eliminate excess regulations, cut wasteful expenditures and restructure
13 federal agencies; and

14 Whereas, during his first term in office Donald J. Trump built over
15 400 miles of the world's most robust and advanced border wall, and he has
16 pledged to further secure our southern border during his second term; and

17 Whereas, President Donald J. Trump stands for a strong manufacturing
18 base and fair agreements for international trade; and

19 Whereas, President Trump steadfastly supports a strong military and
20 strengthening our national defense; and

21 Whereas, President Trump's energy plan includes several ambitious
22 policy prescriptions designed to establish American energy dominance and
23 to remove regulatory burdens on the use of energy, while at the same time
24 ensuring meaningful environmental protection and continued progress toward
25 cleaner air and water; and

26 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Trump helped
27 pass \$3.2 trillion in historic tax relief and reform the tax code; and

1 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Donald J. Trump
2 canceled United States participation in the United Nations Paris Climate
3 Agreement and ended all payments of United States tax dollars to the
4 United Nations Green Climate Fund; and

5 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Trump
6 discontinued the use of "sue and settle" lawsuits that had the effect of
7 imposing government policy on behalf of special interests without
8 congressional authorization or input from the states, other interested
9 parties and the general public; and

10 Whereas, during his first term in office, 4,000,000 jobs were
11 created, more than 400,000 of those in manufacturing, which is the fastest
12 manufacturing growth rate in more than three decades; and

13 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Trump signed the
14 Executive Order on Modernizing the Regulatory Framework for Agricultural
15 Biotechnology Products, which helped bring innovative new technologies to
16 market in American farming and agriculture; and

17 Whereas, President Trump established the Governors' Initiative on
18 Regulatory Innovation to reduce outdated regulations at the state, local
19 and tribal levels; and

20 Whereas, during the third quarter of 2020, the economy grew at a
21 rate of 33.1%, the most rapid GDP growth ever recorded; and

22 Whereas, Donald J. Trump's top priority as president is the best
23 interests of American workers and American families.

24 Wherefore your memorialist, the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House
25 of Representatives concurring, prays:

26 1. That the ~~[Arizona Department of Transportation]~~ [State Board on
27 Geographic and Historic Names] designate State Route 260 as the "Donald J.
28 Trump Highway".

29 2. That the ~~[Arizona Department of Transportation]~~ [State Board on
30 Geographic and Historic Names] approve, place and maintain appropriate
31 signage to identify the Donald J. Trump Highway.

32 3. That the Secretary of State transmit a copy of this Memorial to
