MONIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Health care directives registry; reports; delayed
3 repeal

4 A. On or before December 31, 2025 and June 30, 2026, the department
5 of health services shall submit to the governor, the speaker of the house
6 of representatives and president of the senate a report that includes the
7 following information:

8 1. An overview of the operations and technological capabilities of
9 the health care directives registry.

10 2. The total number of individual accounts.

11 3. The number of individual accounts created in the preceding six
12 months.

13 4. The total number of document uploads.

14 5. The total number of document uploads in the preceding six
15 months.

16 6. The total subscriber organizations using the health care
17 directives registry.

18 7. A description of the subscriber organizations using the health
19 care directives registry in the preceding six months.

20 8. The total number of active health care directives registry
21 users.

22 9. The total number of participant searches.

23 10. The average time to process documents.

24 11. An overview of the past growth in the health care directives
25 registry year over year.

26 B. The department shall provide a copy of the reports required by
27 subsection A of this section to the secretary of state.

28 C. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2026.

29 Sec. 2. Appropriation; department of health services; health
30 care directives registry

31 The sum of \$___ is appropriated from the state general fund in
32 fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of health services for the
33 operation of the health care directives registry.
