URGING THE STATE BOARD ON GEOGRAPHIC AND HISTORIC NAMES TO DESIGNATE STATE ROUTE 260 AS THE "DONALD J. TRUMP HIGHWAY".

1 To the State Board on Geographic and Historic Names:

2 Your memorialist respectfully represents:

3 Whereas, Donald J. Trump was the 45th and is the 47th duly elected
4 President of the United States; and

5 Whereas, in the 2024 presidential election, Donald J. Trump won the
6 popular vote, becoming the first Republican nominee for president to do so
7 in 20 years; and

8 Whereas, Donald J. Trump has established the Department of
9 Government Efficiency, which will dismantle government bureaucracy,
10 eliminate excess regulations, cut wasteful expenditures and restructure
11 federal agencies; and

12 Whereas, during his first term in office Donald J. Trump built over
13 400 miles of the world's most robust and advanced border wall, and he has
14 pledged to further secure our southern border during his second term; and

15 Whereas, President Donald J. Trump stands for a strong manufacturing
16 base and fair agreements for international trade; and

17 Whereas, President Trump steadfastly supports a strong military and
18 strengthening our national defense; and

19 Whereas, President Trump's energy plan includes several ambitious
20 policy prescriptions designed to establish American energy dominance and
21 to remove regulatory burdens on the use of energy, while at the same time
22 ensuring meaningful environmental protection and continued progress toward
23 cleaner air and water; and

24 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Trump helped
25 pass \$3.2 trillion in historic tax relief and reform the tax code; and

26 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Donald J. Trump
27 canceled United States participation in the United Nations Paris Climate
28 Agreement and ended all payments of United States tax dollars to the
29 United Nations Green Climate Fund; and

30 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Trump
31 discontinued the use of "sue and settle" lawsuits that had the effect of
32 imposing government policy on behalf of special interests without
33 congressional authorization or input from the states, other interested
34 parties and the general public; and

35 Whereas, during his first term in office, 4,000,000 jobs were
36 created, more than 400,000 of those in manufacturing, which is the fastest
37 manufacturing growth rate in more than three decades; and

38 Whereas, during his first term in office, President Trump signed the
39 Executive Order on Modernizing the Regulatory Framework for Agricultural
40 Biotechnology Products, which helped bring innovative new technologies to
41 market in American farming and agriculture; and

42 Whereas, President Trump established the Governors' Initiative on
43 Regulatory Innovation to reduce outdated regulations at the state, local
44 and tribal levels; and

1 Whereas, during the third quarter of 2020, the economy grew at a
2 rate of 33.1%, the most rapid GDP growth ever recorded; and

3 Whereas, Donald J. Trump's top priority as president is the best
4 interests of American workers and American families.

5 Wherefore your memorialist, the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House
6 of Representatives concurring, prays:

7 1. That the State Board on Geographic and Historic Names designate
8 State Route 260 as the "Donald J. Trump Highway".

9 2. That the State Board on Geographic and Historic Names approve,
10 place and maintain appropriate signage to identify the Donald J. Trump
11 Highway.

12 3. That the Secretary of State transmit a copy of this Memorial to
13 the chairperson of the State Board on Geographic and Historic Names.
