SENATE BILL 1107

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-2010, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
MOTORCYCLES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2010, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2010. Motorcycle safety fund; administration

5 A. ~~THE~~ motorcycle safety fund is established consisting of
6 monies deposited pursuant to subsection B of this section and monies from
7 gifts, grants and other donations. The director of the governor's office
8 of highway safety shall administer the fund. On notice from the director
9 of the governor's office of highway safety, the state treasurer shall
10 invest and divest monies in the fund as provided in section 35-313, and
11 monies earned from investment shall be credited to the fund. Up to ten
12 percent of the monies in the fund may be used for administrative costs.
13 Monies in the fund are subject to legislative appropriation and are exempt
14 from the provisions of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of
15 appropriations.

16 B. Notwithstanding section 28-2004, ~~through June 30, 2025,~~ the
17 director of the department of transportation shall deposit, pursuant to
18 sections 35-146 and 35-147, \$1 of each motorcycle registration fee
19 collected pursuant to section 28-2003 in the motorcycle safety fund.

20 C. Subject to legislative appropriation, the director of the
21 governor's office of highway safety shall use monies deposited in the
22 motorcycle safety fund pursuant to this section to implement and support
23 voluntary motorcycle education, awareness, training and other programs and
24 may use the monies to cover the cost of materials for motorcycle safety,
25 education and awareness programs.

26 D. ANY FEE, ASSESSMENT OR OTHER LEVY THAT IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW OR
27 ADMINISTRATIVE RULE AND THAT IS COLLECTED AND DEPOSITED IN THE MOTORCYCLE
28 SAFETY FUND SHALL BE HELD IN TRUST. THE MONIES IN THE FUND MAY BE USED
29 ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES PRESCRIBED BY STATUTE AND MAY NOT BE APPROPRIATED OR
30 TRANSFERRED BY THE LEGISLATURE TO FUND THE GENERAL OPERATIONS OF THIS
31 STATE OR TO OTHERWISE MEET THE OBLIGATIONS OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THIS
32 STATE. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY TAXES OR OTHER LEVIES THAT
33 ARE IMPOSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 42 OR 43.

34 Sec. 2. Retroactivity

35 This act applies retroactively to from and after June 29, 2025.
