AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2351 AND 28-2403, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 12, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTIONS 28-2470.27, 28-2470.28, 28-2470.29, 28-2470.30, 28-2470.31, 28-2470.32, 28-2470.33 AND 28-2470.34; AMENDING SECTIONS 28-6501, 28-6991 AND 28-6993, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-123.04; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-1506.03; RELATING TO SPECIAL PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2351, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2351. License plate provided; design

5 A. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall provide to
6 every owner one license plate for each vehicle registered. At the request
7 of the owner and on payment of a fee in an amount prescribed by the
8 director by rule, the department shall provide one additional license
9 plate for a vehicle for which a special plate is requested pursuant to
10 this chapter.

11 B. The license plate shall display the number assigned to the
12 vehicle and to the owner of the vehicle and the name of this state, which
13 may be abbreviated. The director shall coat the license plate with a
14 reflective material that is consistent with the determination of the
15 department regarding the color and design of license plates and special
16 plates. The director shall design the license plate and the letters and
17 numerals on the license plate to be of sufficient size to be plainly
18 readable during daylight from a distance of one hundred feet. In addition
19 to the standard license plate issued for a trailer before August 12, 2005,
20 the director shall issue a license plate for trailers that has a design
21 that is similar to the standard size license plate for trailers but that
22 is the same size as the license plate for motorcycles. The trailer owner
23 shall notify the department which size license plate the owner wants for
24 the trailer.

25 C. In addition to the requirements prescribed in subsection B of
26 this section, for all license plates, including all special plates, that
27 are designed or redesigned on or after September 24, 2022:

28 1. The background color of the license plate shall contrast
29 significantly with the color of the letters and numerals on the license
30 plate and with the name of this state on the license plate.

31 2. The name of this state shall appear on the license plate in
32 capital letters in sans serif font and be three-fourths of an inch in
33 height.

34 D. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall not contract
35 with a nongovernmental entity to purchase or secure reflective material
36 for the plates issued by the department unless the department has made a
37 reasonable effort to secure qualified bids or proposals from as many
38 individual responsible respondents as possible.

39 E. The department shall determine the color and design of the
40 license plate subject to the requirements prescribed by subsections B and
41 C of this section. All plates issued by the department, except the plates
42 that are issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, 28-2413, 28-2414,
43 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through ~~28-2470.26~~ 28-2470.34, 28-2472,
44 28-2473, 28-2474, 28-2475, 28-2476 and 28-4533 and article 14 of this

1 chapter, shall be the same color as and similar in design to the license
2 plate as determined by the department.

3 F. A passenger motor vehicle that is rented without a driver shall
4 receive the same type of license plate as is issued for a private
5 passenger motor vehicle.

6 Sec. 2. Section 28-2403, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
7 read:

8 28-2403. Special plates; transfers; violation; classification

9 A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the department
10 shall issue or renew special plates in lieu of the regular license plates
11 pursuant to the following conditions and procedures and only if the
12 requirements prescribed by this article for the requested special plates
13 are met:

14 1. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, a person
15 who is the registered owner of a vehicle registered with the department or
16 who applies for an original or renewal registration of a vehicle may
17 submit to the department a completed application form as prescribed by the
18 department with the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for special plates
19 in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

20 2. Except for plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412,
21 28-2413, 28-2414, 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through ~~28-2470-26~~
22 28-2470.34, 28-2472, 28-2473, 28-2474, 28-2475 and 28-2476 and article 14
23 of this chapter, the special plates shall be the same color as and similar
24 to the design of the regular license plates that is determined by the
25 department.

26 3. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall
27 issue special plates only to the owner or lessee of a vehicle that is
28 currently registered, including any vehicle that has a declared gross
29 weight, as defined in section 28-5431, of twenty-six thousand pounds or
30 less.

31 4. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, the
32 department shall charge the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for each
33 annual renewal of special plates in addition to the registration fee
34 prescribed by section 28-2003.

35 B. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, on
36 notification to the department and on payment of the transfer fee
37 prescribed by section 28-2402, a person who is issued special plates may
38 transfer the special plates to another vehicle the person owns or leases.
39 Persons who are issued special plates for hearing impaired persons
40 pursuant to section 28-2408 and international symbol of access special
41 plates pursuant to section 28-2409 are exempt from the transfer fee. If a
42 person who is issued special plates sells, trades or otherwise releases
43 ownership of the vehicle on which the plates have been displayed, the
44 person shall immediately report the transfer of the plates to the

1 department or the person shall surrender the plates to the department as
2 prescribed by the director. It is unlawful for a person to whom the
3 plates have been issued to knowingly allow them to be displayed on a
4 vehicle except the vehicle authorized by the department.

5 C. The special plates shall be affixed to the vehicle for which
6 registration is sought in lieu of the regular license plates.

7 D. A person is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor who:

8 1. Violates subsection B of this section.

9 2. Fraudulently gives false or fictitious information in the
10 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant
11 to this article.

12 3. Conceals a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in the
13 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant
14 to this article.

18 28-2470.27. 988 suicide awareness special plates

19 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A PERSON PAYS \$32,000 TO THE
20 DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
21 ISSUE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE
22 \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES. THE DESIGN
23 AND COLOR OF THE 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO
24 APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT.

25 B. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR 988 SUICIDE AWARENESS
26 SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL
27 PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE
28 IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE
29 PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE 988
30 SUICIDE AWARENESS SPECIAL PLATES.

31 C. OF THE \$25 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR THE ORIGINAL

40 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A PERSON PAYS \$32,000 TO THE
41 DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
42 ISSUE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT
43 PROVIDES THE \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL
44 PLATES. THE COLOR AND DESIGN OF THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL

1 PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW
2 A REQUEST FOR YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED
3 WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS
4 SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE
5 DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES IN
6 ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL
7 PLATES.

8 B. OF THE \$25 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR THE ORIGINAL

10 PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE AND \$17 IS AN ANNUAL DONATION.

11 C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND
12 35-147, ALL SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND
13 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991 AND SHALL TRANSMIT ALL DONATIONS COLLECTED
14 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION TO THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATE
15 FUND ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION.

16 D. THE YOUTH CHARITIES ORGANIZATION SPECIAL PLATE FUND IS
17 ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF MONIES DEPOSITED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE
18 DIRECTOR SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. THE FIRST \$32,000 IN THE FUND SHALL
19 BE REIMBURSED TO THE PERSON THAT PAID THE IMPLEMENTATION FEE TO THE
20 DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION. NOT MORE THAN TEN
21 PERCENT OF THE MONIES DEPOSITED IN THE FUND ANNUALLY SHALL BE USED FOR THE
22 COST OF ADMINISTERING THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY
23 APPROPRIATED.

24 E. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ANNUALLY ALLOCATE MONIES FROM THE FUND TO AN
25 ENTITY THAT IS QUALIFIED UNDER SECTION 501(c)(3) OF THE UNITED STATES
26 INTERNAL REVENUE CODE FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES. THE ENTITY MUST:

- 27 1. BE HEADQUARTERED IN THIS STATE.
- 28 2. HAVE BEEN INCORPORATED IN THIS STATE IN MARCH 1996.
- 29 3. EXCLUSIVELY SUPPORT ARIZONA CHILDREN'S CHARITIES THROUGH AT
30 LEAST TWO ANNUAL FUNDRAISING EVENTS.
- 31 4. BE AFFILIATED WITH A MEMBERSHIP-BASED ORGANIZATION THAT IS
32 HEADQUARTERED IN SCOTTSDALE, ARIZONA THAT CONSISTS OF AN ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP
33 OF NOT MORE THAN SIXTY-FIVE MEMBERS UNDER FORTY YEARS OF AGE.

34 F. ON NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST
35 AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES
36 EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

37 28-2470.29. Made in Arizona special plates

38 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A PERSON PAYS \$32,000 TO THE
39 DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
40 ISSUE MADE IN ARIZONA SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE
41 \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE MADE IN ARIZONA SPECIAL PLATES. THE DESIGN AND
42 COLOR OF THE MADE IN ARIZONA SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE
43 DEPARTMENT.

1 B. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR MADE IN ARIZONA SPECIAL
2 PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH:

3 1. A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE DIRECTOR
4 ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY
5 THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED SPECIAL
6 PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE MADE IN ARIZONA SPECIAL

26 ISSUE EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE
27 \$32,000 SHALL DESIGN THE EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES. THE DESIGN
28 AND COLOR OF THE EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO
29 APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR
30 EDUCATION FUNDRAISING SPECIAL PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR

9 INTERNAL REVENUE CODE FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES. THE ENTITY MUST:

10 1. HAVE A MISSION OF COMMUNITY FUNDRAISING TO FUEL ACCESS,
11 INNOVATION AND EXCELLENCE WITHIN ONE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THIS
12 STATE.

13 2. ACHIEVE THIS MISSION THROUGH EVENTS, CAMPAIGNS AND PARTNERSHIPS.

14 3. USE ANY MONIES RAISED THROUGH FUNDRAISING TO PROMOTE EQUITABLE
15 ACCESS TO LEARNING AND ENRICHMENT OPPORTUNITIES, STIMULATE CLASSROOM
16 INNOVATION AND ENSURE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE FOR ONE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
17 IN THIS STATE.

18 F. ON NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST
19 AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES
20 EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

21 G. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT" HAS
22 THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 15-901.

23 28-2470.31. Sorority and fraternity special plates; fund

24 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2025, A SORORITY OR FRATERNITY PAYS \$32,000
25 TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
26 ISSUE SORORITY AND FRATERNITY SPECIAL PLATES. THE SORORITY AND FRATERNITY
27 SPECIAL PLATES SHALL BE OF UNIFORM DESIGN AND SHALL INCLUDE SPACE FOR ONE
28 SORORITY OR FRATERNITY LOGO. A SORORITY OR FRATERNITY THAT MEETS THE
29 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION E OF THIS SECTION AND THAT PROVIDES \$32,000 TO
30 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN A LOGO FOR THE SORORITY OR FRATERNITY THAT IS
31 DIFFERENT FROM DESIGNS FOR OTHER SORORITY OR FRATERNITY LOGOS THAT ARE
32 ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE DESIGN AND COLOR OF THE SORORITY AND
33 FRATERNITY LOGOS ARE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE
34 DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR SORORITY AND FRATERNITY SPECIAL PLATES TO
35 BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE
36 DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM
37 PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED
38 SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE SORORITY AND
39 FRATERNITY SPECIAL PLATES.

40 B. OF THE \$25 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR THE ORIGINAL

11 SORORITY OR FRATERNITY THAT PAID THE IMPLEMENTATION FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT
12 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION AND TO THE SORORITIES AND
13 FRATERNITIES THAT PAID THE SPECIAL PLATE FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT BASED ON
14 THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SPECIAL PLATES ISSUED TO EACH SORORITY OR FRATERNITY
15 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION. THE SORORITY OR FRATERNITY MUST
