HOUSE BILL 2172

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-120.05; RELATING TO EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 1, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-120.05, to read:

4 15-120.05. Crimes against children; parent training;
5 definition

6 A. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A WEBPAGE
7 FOR PARENT TRAINING PROGRAMS AND RESOURCES PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION THAT
8 INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

9 1. AT LEAST ONE TRAINING PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE
10 AND THAT INCLUDES INSTRUCTION ON BOTH CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING AND INTERNET
11 CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN. IF AVAILABLE, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY
12 USE A TRAINING PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE BY THE ARIZONA
13 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

14 2. EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS AND RESOURCES RELATED TO PREVENTING CHILD
15 SEX TRAFFICKING AND INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN.

16 B. ON THE REQUEST OF A PARENT OR GUARDIAN, EACH SCHOOL SHALL
17 PROVIDE INFORMATION ABOUT THE TRAINING PROGRAM AND AVAILABLE RESOURCES
18 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION TO THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A
19 STUDENT AT THE SCHOOL. THE INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN
20 SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

21 1. A STATEMENT THAT, TO ENHANCE CHILD SAFETY AWARENESS, THE PARENT
22 OR GUARDIAN IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING PROGRAM AT
23 LEAST ONCE EACH YEAR.

24 2. A DESCRIPTION OF THE TRAINING PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED FREE OF
25 CHARGE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A, PARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING
26 INFORMATION ABOUT HOW TO ACCESS THE TRAINING PROGRAM.

27 C. THE INFORMATION PRESCRIBED BY SUBSECTION B, PARAGRAPHS 1 AND 2
28 OF THIS SECTION MAY BE PROVIDED TO EACH PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A STUDENT AT
29 THE SCHOOL AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR OR, IF APPLICABLE, WHEN
30 THE STUDENT TRANSFERS TO THE SCHOOL.

31 D. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL" MEANS A SCHOOL
32 DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL IN THIS STATE THAT PROVIDES INSTRUCTION TO
33 STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS OR ANY OF GRADES ONE THROUGH EIGHT.
