AMENDING SECTION 13-2412, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
OBSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-2412, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 13-2412. Refusing to provide truthful name or birth date when
5 lawfully detained; classification

6 A. It is unlawful for a person, after being advised that the
7 person's refusal to answer is unlawful, to fail or refuse to state the
8 person's true full name OR DATE OF BIRTH on request of a peace officer who
9 has lawfully detained the person based on reasonable suspicion that the
10 person has committed, is committing or is about to commit a crime OR A
11 PETTY OFFENSE. A person WHO IS detained under this section shall state
12 the person's true full name, ~~AND DATE OF BIRTH~~ but shall not be compelled
13 to answer any other inquiry of a peace officer.

14 B. A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 2
15 misdemeanor.
