1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 30-221, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 30-221. Authority to issue revenue bonds

5 ~~A.~~ When the authority finds other financing methods or procedure
6 inadvisable, inadequate or insufficient to acquire or construct
7 transmission lines, projects, works or facilities, it may independently or
8 in conjunction with any other optional or alternative plans provided in
9 this chapter issue bonds as provided by this article.

10 Sec. 2. Section 40-209, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
11 read:

12 40-209. Franchises; electric generation suppliers;
13 limitations

14 Regulation of electricity suppliers providing electric generation
15 service is a matter of statewide concern. Cities, including charter
16 cities, towns and counties shall not require franchises for electricity
17 suppliers to provide electric generation service within ~~its~~ THEIR
18 jurisdiction and shall not impose rents, charges or taxes on the use of
19 public streets, roads and alleys on electricity suppliers for the
20 provision of electric generation service within ~~its~~ THEIR jurisdiction,
21 except that a fee equal to the franchise fee of the electric distribution
22 utility may be charged to the electricity supplier on any portion of a
23 retail electricity sale not otherwise subject to a franchise fee made
24 using electric distribution facilities in service territories that are
25 franchised ~~as of the effective date of this section~~ FROM AND AFTER AUGUST
26 20, 1998. Nothing in this ~~subsection~~ SECTION affects the authority of
27 cities, including charter cities, towns and counties to require franchises
28 for electricity suppliers providing electric distribution service within
29 their jurisdiction.
