AMENDING SECTION 25-102, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MARRIAGE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 25-102, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 25-102. Marriage; minimum age

5 A. A person who is ~~at least sixteen years of age and who is~~ under
6 eighteen years of age ~~may marry only if one of the following is true:~~

7 ~~1. The person has received an emancipation order pursuant to title~~
8 ~~12, chapter 15 or from a court in another state and the person's~~
9 ~~prospective spouse is not more than three years older than the person.~~

10 ~~2. The parent or guardian who has custody of the person consents to~~
11 ~~the marriage and the person's prospective spouse is not more than three~~
12 ~~years older than the person.~~

13 ~~B. Persons who are under sixteen years of age shall not marry.~~

14 MAY NOT MARRY.

15 ~~C.~~ B. The clerk of the superior court may not issue a license to a
16 person who is under eighteen years of age ~~and who does not meet the~~
17 ~~requirements of subsection A of this section.~~
