AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 9-500.52; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL POWERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 9, chapter 4, article 8, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 9-500.52, to read:

4 9-500.52. Parking; civil penalties; maximum allowed;
5 expedited payment

6 A. THE GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT ESTABLISH AN
7 ORDINANCE OR REGULATION THAT IMPOSES A CIVIL PENALTY THAT EXCEEDS FOUR
8 HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE DAILY MAXIMUM PARKING FEE THAT IS CHARGED FOR
9 PARKING IN THE SAME PARKING LOCATION AND AT THE SAME DATE AND TIME IN
10 WHICH THE CIVIL PENALTY WAS IMPOSED.

11 B. THE GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPALITY SHALL ESTABLISH THE
12 FOLLOWING CIVIL PENALTIES FOR EXPEDITED PAYMENT OF CIVIL PENALTIES FOR
13 PARKING VIOLATIONS:

14 1. IF THE CIVIL PENALTY IS PAID WITHIN SEVEN BUSINESS DAYS AFTER
15 THE CIVIL PENALTY IS IMPOSED, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MUNICIPALITY MAY
16 NOT IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY OF MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PERCENT OF THE
17 DAILY MAXIMUM PARKING FEE THAT IS CHARGED FOR PARKING IN THE SAME PARKING
18 LOCATION AND AT THE SAME DATE AND TIME IN WHICH THE CIVIL PENALTY WAS
19 IMPOSED.

20 2. IF THE CIVIL PENALTY IS PAID WITHIN EIGHT TO FOURTEEN BUSINESS
21 DAYS AFTER THE CIVIL PENALTY IS IMPOSED, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
22 MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY OF MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED
23 PERCENT OF THE DAILY MAXIMUM PARKING FEE THAT IS CHARGED FOR PARKING IN
24 THE SAME PARKING LOCATION AND AT THE SAME DATE AND TIME IN WHICH THE CIVIL
25 PENALTY WAS IMPOSED.
