AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY AND MILITARY AFFAIRS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; department of emergency and
3 military affairs; exemption; intent

4 A. The sum of \$_____ is appropriated from the state general
5 fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of emergency and military
6 affairs to provide wireless networking technology for reserve service
7 members and units at department training centers.

8 B. The sum of \$_____ is appropriated from the state general
9 fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of emergency and military
10 affairs to establish a program to reimburse service members who are not
11 assigned government computers and who must use personal computers for
12 department purposes.

13 C. The sum of \$_____ is appropriated from the state general
14 fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of emergency and military
15 affairs to establish a lodging-in-kind program for service members who
16 attend drills other than field exercises at a training center that is at
17 least fifty miles from the service member's home and that does not provide
18 barracks facilities.

19 D. The sum of \$_____ is appropriated from the state general
20 fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of emergency and military
21 affairs to upgrade deficient HVAC units and perform ongoing maintenance at
22 training centers.

23 E. The appropriations made in subsections A, B, C and D of this
24 section are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised
25 Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations.

26 F. The legislature intends that the appropriation made in
27 subsection A of this section be considered ongoing funding in future
28 years.

29 Sec. 2. Short title

30 This act may be cited as the "Arizona National Guard Service Member
31 Morale and Readiness Act".
