HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2035

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IX, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA, BY ADDING SECTION 26; RELATING TO TAXATION.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:

3 1. Article IX, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be amended
4 by adding section 26 as follows if approved by the voters and on
5 proclamation of the Governor:

6 26. Vehicle miles traveled; taxing, monitoring and
7 limiting prohibited; exception

8 SECTION 26. A. THIS STATE AND ANY COUNTY, CITY, TOWN,
9 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS
10 STATE MAY NOT DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

11 1. IMPOSE A TAX OR FEE ON ANY PERSON BASED ON THE
12 VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED BY THE PERSON IN A MOTOR VEHICLE.

13 2. ENACT ANY RULE OR LAW TO MONITOR OR LIMIT THE
14 VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED BY A PERSON IN A MOTOR VEHICLE UNLESS
15 THE RULE OR LAW REQUIRES THAT THE PERSON VOLUNTARILY CONSENTS
16 TO THE MONITORING OR LIMITATION.

17 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO EITHER OF THE
18 FOLLOWING:

19 1. AN INTERSTATE AGREEMENT THAT IS ESTABLISHED TO
20 ADMINISTER THE PAYMENT OR REPORTING OF FUEL TAXES OR
21 REGISTRATION FEES FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES THAT OPERATE IN MORE
22 THAN ONE STATE.

23 2. A MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED AND OPERATED BY ANY ENTITY
24 LISTED IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.

25 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
26 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
27 Constitution of Arizona.
