A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 10, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO PRIMARY ELECTIONS.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:

3 1. Article VII, section 10, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to
4 be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 10. Direct primary election law

7 Section 10. The Legislature shall enact a direct
8 primary election law, which shall provide for the nomination
9 of candidates for all elective State, county, and city
10 offices, including candidates for United States Senator and
11 for Representative in Congress. ~~Any person who is registered~~
12 ~~as no party preference or independent as the party preference~~
13 ~~or who is registered with a political party that is not~~
14 ~~qualified for representation on the ballot may vote in the~~
15 ~~primary election of any one of the political parties that is~~
16 ~~qualified for the ballot.~~

17 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
18 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
19 Constitution of Arizona.
