# SENATE BILL 1059

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE EFFICACY OF ARIZONA'S MOVE OVER LAW STUDY COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Efficacy of Arizona's move over law study  
3 committee; membership; duties; report; delayed  
4 repeal

5 A. The efficacy of Arizona's move over law study committee is  
6 established consisting of the following members:

7 1. Two members of the senate, each from a different political  
8 party, who are appointed by the president of the senate. The president of  
9 the senate shall designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson  
10 of the study committee.

11 2. Two members of the house of representatives, each from a  
12 different political party, who are appointed by the speaker of the house  
13 of representatives. The speaker of the house of representatives shall  
14 designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson of the study  
15 committee.

16 3. The director of the department of transportation or the  
17 director's designee.

18 4. The director of the department of public safety or the  
19 director's designee.

20 5. Three representatives of the towing and recovery industry, one  
21 of whom is appointed by the governor, one of whom is appointed by the  
22 president of the senate and one of whom is appointed by the speaker of the  
23 house of representatives.

24 6. Two representatives of law enforcement associations, one of whom  
25 is appointed by the president of the senate and one of whom is appointed  
26 by the speaker of the house of representatives.

27 7. Two representatives from a local chapter of a nationally  
28 recognized organization that advocates for the motor vehicle interests,  
29 one of whom is appointed by the president of the senate and one of whom is  
30 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

31 B. The study committee shall meet at the call of the  
32 cochairpersons.

33 C. Study committee members are not eligible to receive  
34 compensation.

35 D. The study committee shall:

36 1. Conduct a comprehensive study to determine the efficacy of  
37 section 28-775, subsection E, Arizona Revised Statutes, to determine if  
38 additional promotion and education of the law are needed to ensure greater  
39 effectiveness and additional safety measures to help drivers better comply  
40 with yielding to emergency vehicles.

41 2. Identify any additional resources or policy initiatives that  
42 would enhance public safety or improve the efficacy of section 28-775,  
43 Arizona Revised Statutes.

44 3. Propose legislation to address issues identified by the study  
45 committee.

1       4. Review current policies and practices and propose revisions to  
2 improve safety matters for first responders and citizens.

3       5. On or before December 1, 2025, submit a report regarding the  
4 study committee's activities, findings and recommendations for  
5 administrative or legislative action to the governor, the president of the  
6 senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and provide a copy  
7 of this report to the secretary of state.

8       E. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2026.
