SENATE BILL 1460

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; department of health services;
3 midomafetamine; research; exemption

4 A. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the state general
5 fund in fiscal year 2025-2026 to the department of health services to
6 award grants pursuant to title 41, chapter 24, Arizona Revised Statutes,
7 for clinical trials or other research relating to the use of
8 midomafetamine for the treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder. The
9 department may award grants only to entities that both:

10 1. Have completed at least one late-stage clinical trial relating
11 to the use of midomafetamine for the treatment of post-traumatic stress
12 disorder.

13 2. Are currently participating in a United States food and drug
14 administration drug review process relating to the use of midomafetamine
15 for the treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder.

16 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
17 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
18 to lapsing of appropriations.
