SENATE BILL 1558

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE WATER TECHNOLOGY STUDY COMMITTEE.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Water technology study committee; membership;
3 duties; report; delayed repeal

4 A. The water technology study committee is established consisting
5 of the following members:

6 1. Three members of the senate who are appointed by the president
7 of the senate, not more than two of whom are members of the same political
8 party. The president of the senate shall designate one of these members to
9 serve as cochairperson of the committee.

10 2. Three members of the house of representatives who are appointed
11 by the speaker of the house of representatives, not more than two of whom
12 are members of the same political party. The speaker of the house of
13 representatives shall designate one of these members to serve as
14 cochairperson of the committee.

15 3. The director of the department of water resources or the
16 director's designee.

17 4. The director of the water infrastructure finance authority of
18 Arizona or the director's designee.

19 5. The chief executive officer of the Arizona commerce authority or
20 the chief executive officer's designee.

21 6. A representative of a statewide association that advocates on
22 behalf of the businesses of this state appointed by the president of the
23 senate.

24 7. A representative of a state university with experience in water
25 conservation technology who is appointed by the speaker of the house of
26 representatives.

27 8. A representative of a municipal water users association who is
28 jointly appointed by the chairpersons of the house of representatives
29 natural resources, energy and water committee and the senate natural
30 resources committee.

31 B. Committee members who are serving pursuant to subsection A,
32 paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 are nonvoting members.

33 C. The committee shall research and make recommendations regarding
34 the following:

35 1. The existing application of water conservation technology across
36 commercial and industrial property in this state.

37 2. Other states' initiatives to promote water saving technology.

38 3. The efficacy of existing water saving technologies.

39 4. The correlation between sustainable water technologies and the
40 water-energy nexus.

41 5. Potential uses of emerging technologies to manage the water
42 supply of this state more effectively.

1 D. On or before December 31, 2026, the committee shall submit a
2 report regarding the committee's activities and recommendations for
3 administrative or legislative action to the president of the senate and
4 the speaker of the house of representatives and shall provide a copy of
5 this report to the secretary of state.

6 E. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2026.
