A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

**ENACTING AND ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE PEOPLE OF A MEASURE RELATING
TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.**

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Under the power of the referendum, as vested in the Legislature,
4 the following measure, relating to campaign contributions, is enacted to
5 become valid as a law if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
6 Governor:

7 AN ACT

8 AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 1.2, ARIZONA REVISED
9 STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 16-919; RELATING TO CAMPAIGN
10 CONTRIBUTIONS.

11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

12 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 6, article 1.2, Arizona
13 Revised Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-919, to
14 read:

15 16-919. Foreign contributions prohibited; ballot
16 measures; certification

17 A. A FOREIGN CORPORATION OR PERSON SHALL NOT GIVE AND A
18 PERSON, ENTITY OR COMMITTEE SHALL NOT ACCEPT OR USE MONIES OR
19 IN-KIND GOODS OR SERVICES CONTRIBUTED BY A FOREIGN CORPORATION
20 OR PERSON OR A FOREIGN NONGOVERNMENTAL SOURCE TO INFLUENCE THE
21 OUTCOME OF AN ELECTION ON A BALLOT MEASURE.

22 B. A PERSON, ENTITY OR COMMITTEE THAT IS REQUIRED TO
23 FILE CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 16-926 SHALL
24 CERTIFY UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY IN THOSE REPORTS THAT THE
25 PERSON, ENTITY OR COMMITTEE HAS NOT ACCEPTED OR USED MONIES OR
26 IN-KIND GOODS OR SERVICES IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS
27 SECTION.

28 C. FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED SOVEREIGN TRIBAL NATIONS ARE
29 EXEMPT FROM THIS SECTION.

30 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
31 voters at the next general election as provided by article IV, part 1,
32 section 1, Constitution of Arizona.
