SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1040

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS
COUNCIL.

1 Whereas, the State Government Affairs Council (SGAC) was established
2 fifty years ago with the mission to advance and support the state
3 government affairs profession by fostering community and relationship
4 building with peers and elected officials, building knowledge and
5 promoting diverse perspectives in a nonpartisan environment; and

6 Whereas, SGAC's members, consisting of government affairs
7 professionals, have consistently worked to enhance understanding and
8 communication between the public and private sectors. This work has
9 ensured the fair representation of diverse interests and advocated for the
10 advancement of policies that promote offering unparalleled educational
11 opportunities, provided a forum for members and policymakers to convene
12 and collaborate, mentored the next generation of state government affairs
13 professionals and promoted all aspects of diversity; and

14 Whereas, through its collaboration with legislative bodies,
15 administrative agencies and community stakeholders, SGAC has helped build
16 a more responsive, transparent and accountable government at the state
17 level; and

18 Whereas, the fiftieth anniversary of SGAC represents a milestone of
19 achievement and service in the organization's ongoing commitment to
20 excellence in government affairs; and

21 Whereas, SGAC has fostered a forward-thinking platform for
22 addressing emerging challenges in state governance; and

23 Whereas, SGAC has created a legacy of fostering leadership, training
24 and advocacy that has shaped the professional development of thousands of
25 individuals in the field of government relations.

26 Therefore

27 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
28 Representatives concurring:

29 1. That the Members of the Legislature recognize and commend the
30 State Government Affairs Council for its 50 years of dedicated service and
31 significant contributions to enhancing the relationship between state and
32 local governments, businesses and communities.

33 2. That the Members of the Legislature encourage continued support
34 for the State Government Affairs Council's mission and commend its members
35 for their tireless work to advocate for sound policy decisions,
36 transparency and good governance.

37 3. That the Members of the Legislature extend their congratulations
38 to the State Government Affairs Council and its members on reaching this
39 remarkable milestone and acknowledge its enduring influence on this
40 state's government affairs landscape.

41 4. That the Secretary of State of the State of Arizona transmit a
42 copy of this Resolution to the State Government Affairs Council in
43 recognition of its fiftieth anniversary and continued commitment to
44 advancing public policy across this state.
