AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 36-1624.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO GAS
APPLIANCES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 36-1624.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 36-1624.01. Liquefied petroleum gas containers; filling;
5 evacuating; defacing; exception

6 A. A person, other than the owner of a liquefied petroleum gas
7 container or a person authorized in writing by the owner, shall not:

8 1. Fill or refill a liquefied petroleum gas container with
9 liquefied petroleum gas or any other gas or compound.

10 2. Evacuate a liquefied petroleum gas container.

11 3. Deface, erase, obliterate, cover up or otherwise remove or
12 conceal any name, mark, initial or device on a liquefied petroleum gas
13 container.

14 B. This section does not apply to cylinders.

15 ~~C. Notwithstanding section 36-1626, A person who violates this~~
16 ~~section is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor.~~
