AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 25, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 28-8211; RELATING TO AVIATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 25, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 28-8211, to read:

4 28-8211. Automatic dependent surveillance-broadcast system;
5 fees; prohibition; definition

6 A. THIS STATE, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE OR A PRIVATE
7 ENTITY MAY NOT USE ANY SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT OR INFORMATION THAT IS
8 BROADCAST OR COLLECTED BY AN AUTOMATIC DEPENDENT SURVEILLANCE-BROADCAST
9 SYSTEM TO CALCULATE, GENERATE OR COLLECT FEES FROM AN AIRCRAFT OWNER OR
10 OPERATOR IN THE AIR SPACE OF THIS STATE.

11 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "AUTOMATIC DEPENDENT
12 SURVEILLANCE-BROADCAST SYSTEM" MEANS AVIATION SURVEILLANCE TECHNOLOGY THAT
13 USES ANY COMBINATION OF AN AIRCRAFT'S POSITIONING SYSTEM, AIRCRAFT
14 AVIONICS AND GROUND INFRASTRUCTURE TO CREATE A SURVEILLANCE INTERFACE
15 BETWEEN AN AIRCRAFT AND AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL OR OTHER AIRCRAFT, INCLUDING
16 IN AND OUT SIGNALS.
