## **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1024**

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IV, PART 2, SECTION 2, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of  
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article IV, part 2, section 2, Constitution of Arizona, is  
4 proposed to be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on  
5 proclamation of the Governor:

6 2. Qualifications of members of legislature

7 Section 2. No person shall be a member of the  
8 Legislature unless he shall be a citizen of the United States  
9 at the time of his election, nor unless he shall be at least  
10 twenty-five years of age, and shall have been a resident of  
11 Arizona at least three years and, **FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR BEFORE**  
12 **HIS ELECTION, A RESIDENT** of the ~~county~~ DISTRICT from which he  
13 is elected ~~at least one year before his election~~ **AND A MEMBER**  
14 **OF HIS POLITICAL PARTY, IF ANY.**

15 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the  
16 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,  
17 Constitution of Arizona.
