HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1317
(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Appropriation; attorney general; coordinated reentry
3 planning services program; grants

4 A. The sum of \$20,000,000 is appropriated from the opioid claims-
5 related monies deposited in the consumer remediation subaccount of the
6 consumer restitution and remediation revolving fund pursuant to section
7 44-1531.02, subsection C, Arizona Revised Statutes, in fiscal year 2026-
8 2027 to the attorney general to distribute to counties for coordinated
9 reentry planning services programs pursuant to section 11-392, Arizona
10 Revised Statutes.

11 B. The attorney general shall use the monies appropriated in
12 subsection A of this section to:

13 1. Distribute \$2,000,000 to each of Coconino, La Paz, Maricopa,
14 Mohave, Navajo, Pima, Pinal and Yavapai counties in fiscal year 2026-2027
15 to supplement costs associated with the operation of a coordinated reentry
16 planning services program pursuant to section 11-392, Arizona Revised
17 Statutes.

18 2. Make not more than \$1,000,000 available in fiscal year 2026-2027
19 for a statewide database to accommodate counties participating a
20 coordinated reentry planning services program pursuant to section 11-392,
21 Arizona Revised Statutes.

22 3. Award grants pursuant to title 41, chapter 24, Arizona Revised
23 Statutes, to any county not listed in paragraph 1 of this subsection, to
24 establish a coordinated reentry planning services program pursuant to
25 section 11-392, Arizona Revised Statutes. No individual grant awards
26 pursuant to this paragraph shall exceed \$1,000,000."
