**AN ACT**

**DISTRIBUTING COUNTY TRANSPORTATION EXCISE TAX REVENUES.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Distribution; county transportation excise tax  
3 revenues; fiscal year 2026-2027

4 A. Net revenues collected pursuant to section 42-6106, Arizona  
5 Revised Statutes, including interest earned on those revenues, that are  
6 not distributed pursuant to section 42-6106, subsection D, Arizona Revised  
7 Statutes, and that are not refunded pursuant to section 42-1118, Arizona  
8 Revised Statutes, shall be distributed in fiscal year 2026-2027 for the  
9 following projects:

1           B. If the net revenues collected pursuant to section 42-6106,  
2 Arizona Revised Statutes, that are not distributed pursuant to section  
3 42-6101, subsection D, Arizona Revised Statutes, or refunded pursuant to  
4 section 42-1118, Arizona Revised Statutes, exceed \$45,984,000, each amount  
5 distributed in subsection A of this section shall be proportionally  
6 increased.

7           C. If the net revenues collected pursuant to section 42-6106,  
8 Arizona Revised Statutes, that are not distributed pursuant to section  
9 42-6106, subsection D, Arizona Revised Statutes, or refunded pursuant to  
10 section 42-1118, Arizona Revised Statutes, are less than \$45,984,000, each  
11 amount distributed in subsection A of this section shall be proportionally  
12 decreased.
