AN ACT

REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' SERVICES TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON
VETERAN SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Department of veterans' services; veterans
3 services; awareness; report; delayed repeal

4 A. The department of veterans' services shall conduct a study to
5 evaluate and determine the extent to which veterans in this state are
6 aware of existing federal, state or community programs or services that
7 are available to them.

8 B. On or before December 31, 2027, the department of veterans'
9 services shall submit a report that details the findings and
10 recommendations of the study conducted pursuant to subsection A of this
11 section to the governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of
12 the house of representatives. The report shall also include
13 recommendations regarding increasing public awareness in this state for
14 veterans' services using administrative or legislative options and
15 increasing veteran knowledge of available programs and services.

16 C. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2027.
