AMENDING SECTION 1-301, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; REPEALING SECTION 1-308,  
ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO HOLIDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Section 1-301, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

1-301. Holidays enumerated

A. The following days shall be holidays:

1. Sunday of each week.

2. January 1, "New Year's Day".

3. Third Monday in January, "Martin Luther King, Jr./Civil Rights Day".

4. Third Monday in February, "Lincoln/Washington Presidents' Day".

5. MARCH 31, "CESAR CHAVEZ DAY".

6. APRIL 1, "DOLORES HUERTA DAY".

~~7.~~ 7. Second Sunday in May, "Mothers' Day".

~~8.~~ 8. Last Monday in May, "Memorial Day".

~~9.~~ 9. June 2, "Native American Day".

~~10.~~ 10. Third Sunday in June, "Fathers' Day".

~~11.~~ 11. July 4, "Independence Day".

~~12.~~ 12. First Sunday in August, "American Family Day".

~~13.~~ 13. August 14, "National Navajo Code Talkers Day".

~~14.~~ 14. First Monday in September, "Labor Day".

~~15.~~ 15. September 17, "Constitution Commemoration Day".

~~16.~~ 16. Second Monday in October, "Columbus Day".

~~17.~~ 17. November 11, "Veterans' Day".

~~18.~~ 18. Fourth Thursday in November, "Thanksgiving Day".

~~19.~~ 19. December 25, "Christmas Day".

B. When any of the holidays enumerated in subsection A of this section falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as a holiday, with the exception of the holidays enumerated in subsection A, paragraphs 1, ~~5~~, 7, ~~8~~ 9, 10, ~~11~~ 12, ~~and~~ 13 AND 15 of this section.

C. When any of the holidays enumerated in subsection A, paragraphs 2, 5, ~~9~~ 6, 11, ~~15~~ and 17 AND 19 of this section falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as a holiday.

D. When the holiday enumerated in subsection A, paragraph ~~7~~ 9 of this section falls on a day other than Sunday, the Sunday following June 2 shall be observed as that holiday.

E. When the holiday enumerated in subsection A, paragraph ~~11~~ 13 of this section falls on a day other than Sunday, the Sunday following August 14 shall be observed as that holiday.

F. When the holiday enumerated in subsection A, paragraph ~~13~~ 15 of this section falls on a day other than Sunday, the Sunday preceding September 17 shall be observed as that holiday.

Sec. 2. Repeal

Section 1-308, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
