AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 1-323; RELATING TO HOLIDAYS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 1, chapter 3, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 1-323, to read:
4 1-323. National day of racial healing; observation
5 A. THE THIRD TUESDAY IN JANUARY, IN EACH YEAR, SHALL BE OBSERVED AS
6 THE NATIONAL DAY OF RACIAL HEALING.
7 B. NATIONAL DAY OF RACIAL HEALING IS NOT A LEGAL HOLIDAY.
