# HOUSE BILL 2746

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE STUDY COMMITTEE ON TRADE OFFICES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Study committee on trade offices; membership;  
3 duties; report; delayed repeal

4 A. The study committee on trade offices is established consisting  
5 of the following members:

6 1. The chairperson of the house of representatives international  
7 trade committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's  
8 designee, who shall serve as the chairperson.

9 2. The ranking minority party member of the house of  
10 representatives international trade committee, or its successor committee,  
11 or the ranking member's designee.

12 3. The chairperson of the house of representatives commerce  
13 committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's designee.

14 4. The ranking minority party member of the house of  
15 representatives commerce committee, or its successor committee, or the  
16 ranking member's designee.

17 5. The chairperson of the house of representatives government  
18 committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's designee.

19 6. The ranking minority party member of the house of  
20 representatives government committee, or its successor committee, or the  
21 ranking member's designee.

22 7. The chairperson of the house of representatives appropriations  
23 committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's designee.

24 8. The ranking minority party member of the house of  
25 representatives appropriations committee, or its successor committee, or  
26 the ranking member's designee.

27 9. Two members of the house of representatives, appointed by the  
28 speaker of the house of representatives.

29 B. The study committee shall:

30 1. Meet as the study committee deems necessary.

31 2. Review and oversee all of the trade offices in this state under  
32 the authority of the Arizona commerce authority.

33 3. Examine ways to improve the trade offices in this state.

34 4. Solicit input and testimony from stakeholders regarding trade  
35 offices in this state.

36 5. Develop findings and recommendations regarding the effectiveness  
37 of the trade offices in this state.

38 6. On or before December 31, 2028, submit a report of the  
39 committee's findings and recommendations to the speaker of the house of  
40 representatives.

41 C. Committee members are not eligible to receive compensation.

42 D. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2029.
