AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE STUDY COMMITTEE ON TRADE OFFICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Study committee on trade offices; membership;
3 duties; report; delayed repeal
4 A. The study committee on trade offices is established consisting
5 of the following members:
6 1. The chairperson of the house of representatives international
7 trade committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's
8 designee, who shall serve as the chairperson.
9 2. The chairperson of the house of representatives commerce
10 committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's designee.
11 3. The chairperson of the house of representatives government
12 committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's designee.
13 4. The chairperson of the house of representatives appropriations
14 committee, or its successor committee, or the chairperson's designee.
15 5. Two members of the house of representatives, appointed by the
16 speaker of the house of representatives.
17 B. The study committee shall:
18 1. Meet as the study committee deems necessary.
19 2. Review and oversee all of the trade offices in this state under
20 the authority of the Arizona commerce authority.
21 3. Examine ways to improve the trade offices in this state.
22 4. Solicit input and testimony from stakeholders regarding trade
23 offices in this state.
24 5. Develop findings and recommendations regarding the effectiveness
25 of the trade offices in this state.
26 6. On or before December 31, 2028, submit a report of the
27 committee's findings and recommendations to the speaker of the house of
28 representatives.
29 C. Committee members are not eligible to receive compensation.
30 D. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2029.
