AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-2402, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SPECIAL  
LICENSE PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Section 28-2402, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:  
4 28-2402. Special plate fees  
5 The following fees are required:  
6 1. ~~Twenty-five dollars~~ \$50 for each original and for each annual  
7 renewal of special plates issued under this article, except special plates  
8 for hearing impaired persons issued under section 28-2408 and  
9 international symbol of access special plates issued under section  
10 28-2409. THE FEE REQUIRED BY THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS  
11 FOLLOWS:  
12 (a) \$16 TO THE DEPARTMENT AS A SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE.  
13 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND 35-147, THIS  
14 FEE IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991.  
15 (b) \$34 AS AN ANNUAL DONATION TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE FUND OR  
16 DISTRIBUTED TO THE ENTITY THAT IS IDENTIFIED IN THE SECTION ESTABLISHING  
17 THE SPECIAL PLATE.  
18 2. \$25 FOR EACH ORIGINAL AND FOR EACH RENEWAL OF PERSONALIZED  
19 SPECIAL PLATES ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-2406.  
20 ~~2.~~ 3. ~~Twelve dollars~~ \$12 for a transfer of special plates, unless  
21 exempt pursuant to section 28-2403.  
22 Sec. 2. Conforming legislation  
23 The legislative council staff shall prepare proposed legislation  
24 conforming the Arizona Revised Statutes to the provisions of this act for  
25 consideration in the fifty-eighth legislature, first regular session.  
26 Sec. 3. Requirements for enactment; two-thirds vote  
27 Pursuant to article IX, section 22, Constitution of Arizona, this  
28 act is effective only on the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of  
29 the members of each house of the legislature and is effective immediately  
30 on the signature of the governor or, if the governor vetoes this act, on  
31 the subsequent affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members  
32 of each house of the legislature.
