AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-2406, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ARIZONA
EMPOWERMENT SCHOLARSHIP ACCOUNTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-2406, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-2406. Arizona empowerment scholarship accounts; quarterly
5 reports

6 Within sixty days after the last day of each calendar quarter, the
7 department shall submit a report, consistent with federal law, to the
8 governor, the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of
9 representatives, the director of the joint legislative budget committee
10 and the director of the governor's office of strategic planning and
11 budgeting. The report must include all of the following:

12 1. The number of qualified students disaggregated by:

13 (a) Eligibility category.

14 (b) For qualified students who are eligible pursuant to section
15 15-2401.01, the number of qualified students who attended a public school
16 in this state in the school year immediately preceding the first year of
17 each qualified student's enrollment in the Arizona empowerment scholarship
18 account program.

19 (c) Grade level.

20 (d) The school district or charter school that each qualified
21 student attended in the school year immediately preceding the first year
22 of each qualified student's enrollment in the Arizona empowerment
23 scholarship account program, if applicable.

24 (e) English language learners.

25 (f) Qualified students who are enrolled in the Arizona empowerment
26 scholarship account program as a ~~student~~ CHILD with a disability.

27 (g) The zip code of each qualified student's permanent residence.

28 2. The annual award amount associated with each Arizona empowerment
29 scholarship account.

30 3. The amount of approved expenses disaggregated by type of expense
31 as described in section 15-2402, subsection B, paragraph 4.

32 4. A LIST OF EACH APPROVED EXPENSE, INCLUDING THE PRICE OF EACH
33 GOOD OR SERVICE.

34 5. A LIST OF EACH EXPENSE OR REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT THAT WAS
35 DISAPPROVED, INCLUDING THE PRICE OF EACH GOOD OR SERVICE.

37 This act may be cited as the "Follow the Money Act".
