A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IV, PART 2, SECTION 3, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:

3 1. Article IV, part 2, section 3, Constitution of Arizona, is
4 proposed to be amended as follows if approved by the voters and on
5 proclamation of the Governor:

6 3. Sessions of legislature; special sessions;
7 limitation of subjects for consideration

8 Section 3. The sessions of the legislature shall be
9 held annually at the capitol of ~~the~~ THIS state, and shall
10 commence on the second Monday of January of each year AND
11 SHALL ADJOURN SINE DIE NOT LATER THAN APRIL 30 OF EACH YEAR.
12 The governor may call a special session, whenever in ~~his~~ THE
13 GOVERNOR'S judgment it is advisable. In calling a special
14 session, the governor shall specify the subjects to be
15 considered, and at ~~such~~ THE special session no laws shall be
16 enacted except ~~such as~~ THOSE THAT relate to the subjects
17 mentioned in the call.

18 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
19 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
20 Constitution of Arizona.
