A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; REPEALING ARTICLE
XXV, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO THE RIGHT TO WORK.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:

3 1. Article XXV, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be repealed
4 as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the Governor:

5 Article XXV, Constitution of Arizona, relating to the
6 right to work, is repealed.

7 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
8 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
9 Constitution of Arizona.
