AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 5; RELATING TO STATE AGENCIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding article 5, to read:

4 ARTICLE 5. STATE AGENCIES

5 36-281. Administrative deficiencies; cure period; definition

6 A. AN AGENCY MAY NOT TAKE ANY DISCIPLINARY OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION
7 AGAINST A FACILITY THAT THE AGENCY EITHER CONTRACTS WITH OR LICENSES IF
8 ONLY AN ADMINISTRATIVE DEFICIENCY OR DEFICIENCIES ARE IDENTIFIED. THE
9 AGENCY MUST ALLOW THE FACILITY SEVENTY-TWO HOURS TO CURE ANY IDENTIFIED
10 ADMINISTRATIVE DEFICIENCY BEFORE THE AGENCY MAY TAKE ANY DISCIPLINARY OR
11 ENFORCEMENT ACTION.

12 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "AGENCY" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT
13 OF HEALTH SERVICES, THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM OR THE
14 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY.
