AMENDING TITLE 25, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 25-419; RELATING TO LEGAL DECISION-MAKING AND PARENTING
TIME.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 25, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 25-419, to read:

4 25-419. Professional personnel; liability

5 A PARENT MAY BRING A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST ANY PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL
6 WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE COURT IN ANY MATTER INVOLVING LEGAL
7 DECISION-MAKING OR PARENTING TIME FOR A DEVIATION FROM THE PROFESSIONAL
8 PERSONNEL'S ETHICS AND STANDARDS THAT ARE PRESCRIBED BY THE PROFESSIONAL
9 PERSONNEL'S LICENSING AGENCY AND LICENSING REQUIREMENTS. A PARENT SHALL
10 COMMENCE AN ACTION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION WITHIN FOUR YEARS AFTER THE
11 CAUSE OF ACTION ACCRUES.
