AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE STATE TREASURER.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; state treasurer; Queen Creek police
3 department; specialized law enforcement pilot
4 program; exemption

5 A. The sum of \$1,255,500 is appropriated from the state general
6 fund in fiscal year 2026-2027 to the state treasurer for distribution to
7 the town of Queen Creek for the Queen Creek police department to establish
8 a three-year pilot program for specialized law enforcement. The
9 specialized law enforcement pilot program shall focus on the following:

- 10 1. Prevention of incidents of runaway youth.
- 11 2. Protection of at-risk youth from exploitation.
- 12 3. Enhancement of the investigative capability of the police
13 department.
- 14 4. Strengthening collaboration with care providers and state
15 agencies.
- 16 5. Production of a model framework for statewide replication.

17 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
18 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
19 to lapsing of appropriations.
