1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; department of administration;
 3 pilot program expansion; local law enforcement
 4 agencies; exemption

5 A. The following amounts are appropriated from the state general
 6 fund in fiscal year 2026-2027 to the department of administration to
 7 distribute to the following entities to expand participation in the pilot
 8 program to connect the records management systems and computer-aided
 9 dispatch systems pursuant to Laws 2024, chapter 209, section 127:
