A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENACTING AND ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE PEOPLE OF A MEASURE RELATING
TO MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENT LICENSES.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Under the power of the referendum, as vested in the Legislature,
4 the following measure, relating to marijuana, is enacted to become valid
5 as a law if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the Governor:

6 AN ACT

7 AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 28.2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
8 ADDING SECTION 36-2869; RELATING TO MARIJUANA.

9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

10 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 28.2, Arizona Revised
11 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-2869, to read:

12 36-2869. Attorney general; investigation; legal action;
13 definition

14 A. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
15 DEPARTMENT, MAY INVESTIGATE AND COMMENCE LEGAL ACTION AGAINST
16 ANY MARIJUANA FACILITY AGENT THAT ENTERS INTO A PREDATORY
17 AGREEMENT OR FRAUDULENTLY ACQUIRES A MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENT
18 LICENSE. ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION MAY
19 INCLUDE:

- 20 1. REVOCATION OF ANY MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE.
21 2. DENIAL OR REVOCATION OF A MARIJUANA FACILITY AGENT'S

22 CARD.

23 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "PREDATORY
24 AGREEMENT" MEANS ANY AGREEMENT SIGNED BEFORE OR WITHIN
25 EIGHTEEN MONTHS AFTER A MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE UNDER
26 THE SOCIAL EQUITY OWNERSHIP PROGRAM WAS ISSUED THAT REQUIRED
27 THE ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL OFFICER OR BOARD MEMBER WHO HELD AT
28 LEAST FIFTY-ONE PERCENT OWNERSHIP OF THE MARIJUANA
29 ESTABLISHMENT TO SELL, TRANSFER, ASSIGN, PLEDGE, ENCUMBER OR
30 OTHERWISE GIVE CONTROL OF THE ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL OFFICER'S OR
31 BOARD MEMBER'S OWNERSHIP INTEREST, VOTING RIGHTS OR
32 OPERATIONAL CONTROL FOR LESS THAN MINIMUM FAIR MARKET VALUE OR
33 UNDER TERMS THAT A REASONABLE PERSON WOULD CONSIDER
34 UNCONSCIONABLE.

35 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
36 voters at the next general election as provided by article IV, part 1,
37 section 1, Constitution of Arizona.
