AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-2010, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 28-2014; RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2010, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2010. Motorcycle safety fund; administration

5 A. The motorcycle safety fund is established consisting of monies
6 deposited pursuant to subsection B of this section and monies from gifts,
7 grants and other donations. The director of the governor's office of
8 highway safety shall administer the fund. On notice from the director of
9 the governor's office of highway safety, the state treasurer shall invest
10 and divest monies in the fund as provided in section 35-313, and monies
11 earned from investment shall be credited to the fund. Up to ten percent
12 of the monies in the fund may be used for administrative costs. Monies in
13 the fund are subject to legislative appropriation and are exempt from the
14 provisions of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

15 B. Notwithstanding section 28-2004, the director of the department
16 of transportation shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147,
17 \$1 of each motorcycle registration fee collected pursuant to section
18 28-2003 in the motorcycle safety fund.

19 C. Subject to legislative appropriation, the director of the
20 governor's office of highway safety shall use monies deposited in the
21 motorcycle safety fund pursuant to this section **FOR THE FOLLOWING**
22 **PURPOSES:**

23 **1. UP TO SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT** to implement and support voluntary
24 motorcycle education, awareness, training and other programs and may use
25 the monies to cover the cost of materials for motorcycle safety, education
26 and awareness programs.

27 **2. UP TO TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT FOR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MOTORCYCLE DRIVER**
28 **EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR PERSONS WHO ARE FROM RURAL OR LOW-INCOME AREAS IN**
29 **THIS STATE TO INCREASE ACCESS TO MOTORCYCLE TRAINING PROGRAMS.**

30 D. Any fee, assessment or other levy that is authorized by law or
31 administrative rule and that is collected and deposited in the motorcycle
32 safety fund shall be held in trust. The monies in the fund may be used
33 only for the purposes prescribed by statute and may not be appropriated or
34 transferred by the legislature to fund the general operations of this
35 state or to otherwise meet the obligations of the general fund of this
36 state. This subsection does not apply to any taxes or other levies that
37 are imposed pursuant to title 42 or 43.

38 Sec. 2. Title 28, chapter 7, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
39 is amended by adding section 28-2014, to read:

40 28-2014. Motorcycle registration; requirements

41 **THE DEPARTMENT MAY RENEW A REGISTRATION FOR A MOTORCYCLE ONLY IF AT**
42 **LEAST ONE OF THE REGISTERED OWNERS OF THE MOTORCYCLE IS LICENSED TO**
43 **LEGALLY OPERATE A MOTORCYCLE IN THIS STATE, EXCEPT THE DEPARTMENT MAY**
44 **ISSUE A THIRTY-DAY TEMPORARY REGISTRATION IF THE PERSON SHOWS VALID PROOF**

1 OF ENROLLMENT IN A MOTORCYCLE TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
2 IF THE REGISTERED OWNER OF A MOTORCYCLE IS A TRUST, A TRUSTEE NAMED IN THE
3 TRUST MUST BE LEGALLY LICENSED TO OPERATE A MOTORCYCLE TO RENEW A
4 REGISTRATION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A
5 MOTORCYCLE THAT IS OWNED BY A BUSINESS.
6 Sec. 3. Effective date
7 This act is effective from and after December 31, 2026.
