ON THE DEATH OF BRADLEY "BRAD" BRAUER.

1 Bradley "Brad" Brauer passed away on January 23, 2026 at the age  
2 of 61.

3 Brad was born on July 7, 1964, at Fort Rucker, Alabama to Sally  
4 Brauer and Jimmy Mac Brasher. He grew up surrounded by a family that  
5 instilled in him the values of honesty, compassion and service, which he  
6 carried throughout every aspect of his life.

7 In 1983, Brad moved to Arizona, where he later attended Arizona  
8 State University. Brad built a successful career as a realtor, serving  
9 his clients with integrity and kindness for more than 20 years. His work  
10 extended far beyond real estate as he was an active and respected presence  
11 in his community, most notably as President of the Willo Neighborhood  
12 Association. Brad's leadership and advocacy for neighborhood, city and  
13 state policies leaves a lasting impact on countless residents.

14 In his personal life, Brad's heart belonged to his husband of ten  
15 years, Andrew. Their partnership was rooted in devotion, laughter,  
16 adventure and deep respect.

17 Music played a big role in Brad's life. He especially loved the  
18 classic rock and roll of the 1960s through the 1980s, loved his vinyl  
19 records and always said that was the best way to listen to the heart and  
20 soul of a song.

21 Brad is survived by his husband, Andrew Sansoni, his mother, Sally  
22 Brauer, his sister, Lynne Brasher, his brother, Scott Brauer, his  
23 sisters-in-law, Laura Brasher and Stephanie Brasher, his nephew, Dallas  
24 Brasher, and his niece, Lexi Brauer. Brad's warm heart, leadership and  
25 radiant spirit touched all who knew him, and his absence leaves a lasting  
26 void in the community he so passionately served.
