Representative Clodfelter Introduces Legislation to Establish Tax Holiday for Parents Purchasing School Supplies

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – Representative Todd Clodfelter (R-10) has introduced <u>HB</u> <u>2382</u>, which will establish a tax holiday for the purchase of school supplies for children by parents or guardians.

"Even with the Legislature adding over \$300 million in new spending for K-12 education last year, we must continue to look for every opportunity to benefit the education of our students and their families," said Representative Clodfelter. "A tax holiday on school supplies will help ensure that students are getting the tools they need for their education."

This bill would allow for cities, towns, and municipalities to opt out of this tax holiday.

Last month, Representative Clodfelter introduced HB 2377, legislation that will establish a tax credit for teachers who spend personal money on classroom expenses.
